

RULES / GUIDELINES FOR GRANTING RECOGNITION TO NEW RESEARCH PROGRAMMES IN THE EXISTING AIDED / UN-AIDED COLLEGES

1. The tuition fees and other fees except those coming under the purview of the University should be levied from the students, as prescribed by Government from time to time.
2. College Management shall clear all the dues to the University, pending advances etc., before grant of recognition by the University.
3. No Department in an Affiliated college shall be approved to offer M.Phil programme without Master's degree course in the discipline concerned (both laboratory and non-laboratory subjects).
4. A department in an affiliated college may be considered for approval to offer M.Phil program only after the completion of the first batch of Master's degree course in the discipline concerned (Both Lab and Non lab).
5. Postgraduate departments of colleges affiliated to the University and recognized as having necessary facilities for carrying out research branch of study concerned by the University procedures provided that the department in an affiliated college should have been offering the post graduate course concerned for a minimum period of Three years for Recognition of Departments for the conduct of Ph.D. Programmes .
6. Research Department shall have at least two recognized Ph.D guides to consider grant of recognition to conduct M.Phil/Ph.D. Programmes.
7. The maximum intake of candidates for full-time and part-time M.Phil/Ph.D. programme in each department of the institution will be fixed by the inspection commission constituted by the University.
8. Full signed minutes of the College Committee Minutes/Governing Council Minutes shall be specific for starting new research programmes during a particular year. If the programmes are to be started next year, then the college shall submit a fresh resolution of the College Committee/Governing Council for starting the course during that year. College shall also enclose evidence for inviting the University Nominee to the College Committee/Governing Council meeting.
9. The Colleges, which applied to start research programmes during 2007-2008 shall not be permitted to renew their applications to start the programmes during 2008-2009. They have to apply afresh to start the new research programmes during 2008-2009.
10. The College, which applied for Permanent increase in intake to research Programmes during 2007-2008 shall not be permitted to renew their applications to Permanent increase in intake to research programmes during 2008-2009. They have to apply afresh for permanent increase in intake to research programmes during 2008-2009.
11. Inspection Commission appointed to inspect and report on the infrastructural facilities in the affiliated colleges are requested to give a detailed report.
12. The affiliation fee of Rs.1,00,000/- has to be paid by the Colleges for getting Recognition to M.Phil and Ph.D. programmes individually and put together for the academic year 2008-2009.
13. Colleges should display in the Notice Boards, a copy of the communication from the University granting recognition for the programmes, during the period when admissions are made.
