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1. BRIEF PROFILE OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Bharathiar University was established at Coimbatore by the Government of Tamilnadu in February, 1982 under the provision of the Bharathiar University Act, 1981 (Act I of 1982). The University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, recognized the University in May 1985 for the purpose of grants. Bharathiar University is a member of the association of Indian Universities and Commonwealth Universities, hence, the degrees awarded are mutually recognized by each other.

Bharathiar University is accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC and placed among the top ten universities at the national level.

The University is situated at the backdrop of Maruthamalai Hills in the Western Ghat range, in a sprawling campus of 1000 acres of land, 15 kms from the City of Coimbatore. As of now, the University has 143 affiliated Colleges- 85 Arts and Science Colleges, 49 College of Education, 8 Management Institutions and 1 Air Force Administration College. In addition, there are 18 Research Institutes of the State and Central Governments, which are recognized by the University for Research purpose. All these institutions cater to the educational needs of more than 1,60,000 students and research scholars.

2. BRIEF PROFILE OF THE SCHOOL OF DISTANCE EDUCATION

The School of Distance Education (SDE) of Bharathiar University was established during the academic year 1991-92. The school has limited its operation for the obvious reason of strengthening its base to provide quality education. Having realized the objective, the school has started extending its action by identifying and approving study centres throughout the country to help achieve higher gross enrolment ratio and higher literacy rate.

The school at present has 125 centres spreading over 23 states as study centres cum spot admission centres, and the number is steadily increasing as more and more evinced interest in starting study centres.

The school directly admits candidates and conducts the personal contact programmes at specified Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) centres in Coimbatore. Study centers cum spot admission centres enroll candidates and conduct the Personal Contact Programmes in their centres or at specified regional centres. The study materials prepared in the prescribed format of Distance Education Council (DEC) are provided to the students supplemented by compact discs for hassle free use anywhere at anytime without the burden of carrying the course materials. 2. Other UG / PG / Diploma / PG Diploma Courses: Rs.100/-

The Registration fee paid is not refundable or adjustable under any circumstances. Applications received without the registration fee will be rejected.

1. A demand draft for the registration fee prescribed drawn in favour of the Director, School of Distance Education, payable at Coimbatore.
2. If the application is downloaded from the University Website, enclose a DD for the prescribed registration fee and the cost of application.
3. Attested photocopies of the statement of marks and other relevant certificates pertaining to the qualifying examinations.
4. A recent passport size (5 cm X 7 cm) photograph pasted on the first page of the application form.

5. Self addressed stamped acknowledgement card.

6. Equivalent certificate obtained from the Association of Indian Universities, if the candidate has graduated from a foreign university.

Eligible candidates will be provisionally admitted. On receipt of the communication informing the provisional admission, the applicant must send all the required certificates in original and the course fee either in full or its first installment. After checking the original certificates, the enrollment letter confirming the admission will be sent.

All the original certificates will be returned immediately after scrutiny except the +2 certificates which will be sent after due verification by the appropriate Government authorities. If certificates are not received within a month, candidates can represent the matter directly to the Grievance Cell / Dean / Director of the School.

Students admitted at the study centres cum spot admission centres can alternatively submit the original certificates at the centres, which will be returned after due verification by the university authorities.

Spot Admission

Spot admission is done for all courses in all study centres cum spot admission centres and in the office and city centres of the School of Distance Education, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore - 641 046.

For spot admission submit duly filled in application with all relevant certificates in original, their photocopies, DD for the registration fee, and course fee in full or its first installment at any one of the spot admission centres and get admitted. The original certificates will be handed over to the candidates immediately along with the provisional admission intimation and the

identity card duly signed by the designated authority of the School of Distance Education.

Re-admission

If the student had earlier been a student of the first or second year of the programme in a college affiliated to Bharathiar University or other recognized institution or School of Distance Education or Directorate or Institute of Correspondence Course of a recognized university and had discontinued for whatever reasons, he/she is eligible for re-admission into the second / third year respectively, on payment of a re-admission fee of Rs.525/-.

Re-admission is possible only into the courses which are currently offered by the School of Distance Education. The syllabus in vogue will be applicable to the re-admitted students and exemption will be granted for the subjects already completed.

Direct Admission to Second or Third year of Study

If a candidate had already studied first year or second year in a fulltime programme in a college affiliated to Bharathiar University or a recognized University, he/she is eligible for admission directly into the second or third year of the corresponding programme of the School of Distance Education.

Direct admission will be made only to the courses which are currently offered by the School of Distance Education.

Concurrent Admission

Students undergoing regular courses in colleges can seek admission, if eligible, to UG/ PG degree or Diploma/PG Diploma programme offered by the School of Distance Education concurrently. Such applicants are required to submit bonafide student certificate along with the application. Subjects common for the two programmes, if any, will be considered for granting exemption as per rules.

Application form and Prospectus are issued and filled in application are accepted round the year. Admissions are made as given below based on the date of receipt of filled in applications.

Academic Year Batch - Filled in applications received and admitted between **1st May and 30th November**

Calendar Year Batch - Filled in applications received and admitted between **1st December and 30th April**

Exemption of Subjects

Students who have already passed subjects prescribed for the same course at some other institution prior to admission in the School of Distance Education shall be considered for granting exemption from appearing for examinations in those subjects. An application to this effect shall be made with copies of syllabi of relevant subjects for which exemption is sought (in duplicate), duly attested by the Head of the Institution in which

the student had pursued the course and successfully completed the subjects, along with the statement of marks issued by the competent authority. A sum of Rs.525/- shall be paid as fee for considering such exemption of subjects. The requisition should be addressed to the Director, School of Distance Education. However, the decision of the University shall be final with regard to granting of exemption of subjects.

7. Payment of Fees

All payments to the School of Distance Education should be made only by means of a crossed MICR Demand Draft, or BOI challan issued by Bharathiar University branch, accompanied by the appropriately filled in fee remittance form. The enclosed fee remittance form may be duplicated for further use.

The enrollment number and the name of the student should be written on the reverse side

of the Demand Draft or Challan to ensure proper accounting in his/her name. Challan issued by any other bank and by any other branch of Bank of India will not be accepted.

Fees once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances. If the fee is paid after the due date a penal fee of Rs.100/- has to be paid along with the course fee.

Postal and Handling Charges

Students from states other than Tamilnadu, Kerala, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh and the Union Territory of Puducherry have to pay to the university an additional amount of Rs.500/-

8. Enrolment Number

Enrolment Number will be assigned to the students on admission. The Enrolment number will be intimated through the admission letter. This number will be valid for the entire duration of the course of study. Students should indicate their Enrolment Number in all communication addressed to the School of Distance Education for prompt response.

9. Identity Card

An identity card will be issued on admission. This is valid for the entire duration of the course. The students will be permitted to attend the Personal Contact Programme only on production of their ID cards so also for the issue of study materials.

Hall Ticket for the University Examination will be issued by the Chief Superintendents only on production of this ID card.

Students are advised to keep their ID card safely, as they provide proof of their bonafide student status. In case of loss of the ID card, a duplicate will be issued on a written request accompanied by a fee of Rs.50/-

However, students who have completed the duration of the course will be issued only bonafide certificates for the purpose of appearing for the supplementary examination.

10. Change of Name, Address, Study Centre, Course and Specialization

If a student has changed his/her name officially during the course of study, the name change has to be effected in the official records of the SDE also. Application to this effect should be made to the Director, School of Distance Education in the prescribed format along with the fee of Rs. 325/-

In case of change of address, a letter in the enclosed format with the current address and a fee of Rs.50/- should be sent to the School of Distance Education and the acknowledgement received from the SDE in this regard should be kept along with the ID card. A minimum of four weeks time is required for effecting the change of name / address.

Students opting for a change of Study Centre, should make an application to that effect, along with a fee of Rs.100/-. Change of study centre will be given effect only at the beginning of the academic/calendar year as the case may be.

Change of Course / Specialization is permitted within one month of admission to the course on specific request and payment of the fee of Rs. 500/-.

11. Syllabus and Supportive Study Material

The relevant syllabus copy will be issued at the beginning of the programme. Study material prepared as per the format of Distance Education Council will be supplied at the allotted PCP centres or study centre cum spot admission centres where they were admitted by production of the ID card. Students admitted directly at the school of distance education and its city centres can get the study materials in person at the PCP centres during the period of contact classes or at SDE or by post. Study materials, on any account will not be issued to any person (even parents, brothers, sisters or friends) other than the students.

The students should make their own arrangements to procure other prescribed reference / text books. Though Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Hindi Urudu, Arabi and French are offered as languages under Part I of the under-graduate Degree programmes, the school will supply study-material for Tamil subject only.

12. Personal Contact Programme

Personal Contact Programme will be conducted at specified centres. The dates and venue for the PCP will be communicated to students, who were admitted directly at the School of Distance Education, individually upon confirmation of their admission. The study centres cum spot admission centres will intimate the same to the students admitted by them. 50% of attendance for theory and practical classes is compulsory. The School of Distance Education reserves the right to conduct or not to conduct Personal Contact Programme in a subject for valid reasons.

13. University Examinations

University examinations are conducted twice a year in May / June and November / December at specified examination centers.

Computer generated examination application forms, Hall tickets, and examination schedule will be sent directly to eligible students from the office of the Controller of Examinations, Bharathiar University. After furnishing the required information as per the instruction and affixing the signature in the places earmarked on the application and the hall ticket, the application should be sent directly to the Controller of Examinations on or before the stipulated dates.

The student appearing for the examination for the first time should register his/her name for all subjects by remitting the prescribed fee. Candidates can appear for the arrears subjects by registering for the same as per the instruction given in the computer generated application forms and payment of the fee there for. The examination fee should be paid in the form of DD drawn in favour of the Controller of Examinations, Bharathiar University, payable at Coimbatore.

Centres of University examinations will be intimated to the students by the Controller of Examinations and the students should specify their opted center of examinations in

the space provided in the computer generated application forms.

Students will not be permitted to change their examination centres once their examination applications are submitted. Students shall collect their hall tickets for the examinations from the Chief Superintendent of the examination centre opted, on production of their identify cards during the three working days prior to the commencement of the examinations.

14. Blind Students – Provision to Engage Scribes

Blind students shall write their examinations through the help of scribes. Such students are instructed to request the Chief Superintendent concerned of university examinations well in advance for the appointment of scribes as per the University rules.

15. Project Work

Each student should carry out a project during the final year of the programme, wherever prescribed. The specific directions regarding the project work will be issued at appropriate time.

Passing Minimum and Classification of Successful Candidates for UG/PG/ PG Diploma and Diploma Courses.

UG / Diploma: - Candidates who have secured 40% of marks in each paper shall be declared to have passed the examination. Candidates who have obtained not less than 60 marks shall be placed in First Class, and those who have obtained marks between 50 percent and above shall be placed in Second Class and the rest of the successful candidates shall be placed in Third Class. The failed

candidates shall appear for the paper/papers in which they have failed in the subsequent examinations.

PG / PG Diploma: - Candidates who have secured 50% of marks in each paper shall be declared to have passed the examination. Candidates who have obtained not less than 60 marks shall be placed in First Class, and those who have obtained marks between 50 and above but less than 60 percent shall be placed in Second Class. The failed candidates shall appear for the paper/papers in which they have failed in the subsequent examinations.

17. Improvement Examinations

Students can apply and appear for improvement for one or more theory papers within one year after the completion of the course and such improvement is restricted at one time only. The fee for improvement is Rs.500/- per paper in addition to the regular examination fee.

18. Retotalling / Revaluation

Provision for retotalling and revaluation is available for all courses. The application for retotalling or revaluation must be made within 15 days from the receipt of the statement of marks. Applications for revaluation and retotalling can be downloaded from the University Website. The fee prescribed for retotalling per paper is Rs.200/- and for revaluation is Rs.300/- The filled in application for retotalling and revaluation should be **sent only to the Controller of Examinations** along with the fee in the form of DD drawn in favour of the Controller of Examinations, Bharathiar University, Payable at Coimbatore.

19. Course Certificate

The ID card is the proof of bonafide-student status. A course certificate will be issued by the School of Distance Education, to the student on specific request.

20. Provisional Certificate

On successful completion of the course & payment of fee prescribed the provisional certificate will be sent along with the final statement of marks directly to the students by the COE.

21. Consolidated Statement of Marks

Students who have obtained the provisional certificate and completed the entire course of study in this University may obtain consolidated statements of marks, by applying directly to the Controller of Examinations, in the prescribed form along with the requisite fee.

22. Degree Certificate

Degree certificate of successful students can be obtained directly from the Controller of Examinations, by applying in the prescribed form along with the requisite fee when convocation notification is issued.

23. Migration Certificate

Some universities while admitting students insist on the production of Migration Certificates. Migration certificate can be obtained by applying in the prescribed form, with the requisite fees, to the Controller of Examinations, Bharathiar University.

24. Duplicate Certificate

Duplicate copies of the statements of marks, consolidated statement of marks, provisional certificate, degree certificate, migration certificate, etc may also be obtained by applying to the Controller of Examinations.

25. Rectification of Mistakes in the Certificate

In case any certificate issued either by the Director, SDE or the Controller of Examinations has incorrect information or spelling mistakes, the original certificate should be returned along with the request for rectification to the officer concerned within 10 days of receipt of the concerned certificate.

Belated request for rectification may entail payment of penalty fees.

26. Scholarship For SC/ ST Students

Scholarships for SC/ ST students admitted to various programmes can avail themselves of the scholarship made available by their respective state governments. However, the students are instructed to remit the full fees, at the time of admission and it will be refunded as and when the scholarship is granted by the concerned authorities. Application forms for Scholarship in Tamil Nadu can be obtained from the District Adi-Dravida Welfare Officer. Completed application should be submitted to the Director, School of Distance Education within a month from the date of admission.

27. Discipline

Students are expected to behave well and maintain discipline during the Personal Contact Programme and practical sessions at the study centers. Any complaint about indiscipline will be viewed seriously, and such students will be removed from the rolls of SDE.

28. Disputes

With regard to any dispute arising in all matters ranging from admission to conduct of examinations, a written representation with relevant documents, if any, shall be submitted to the authority concerned for action.

29. Legal Jurisdiction

All disputes that may arise in or from the affairs and administration of the SDE shall lie within the legal jurisdiction of the city of Coimbatore only.

The School of Distance Education is an integral part of the University since it has been established by the Syndicate of the University. Hence, the School shall come within the purview of the statute 3 of chapter III of the Statutes of Bharathiar University which states, "In all suits and other legal proceedings by or against the University, the pleadings shall be signed and verified by the Registrar and all such suits and proceedings shall be issued to and served on the Registrar". Therefore, in all suits and others legal proceedings against the School of Distance Education, all processes in such suits and proceedings shall be issued to and served on the Registrar of Bharathiar University only.
